Continue to earn points for recycling through 2008.

PurchasEdge continues to offer points for recycling empty Original HP inkjet and LaserJet cartridges through the HP Planet Partners program. This free, easy and convenient process for earning additional PurchasEdge points will help you preserve the planet while earning PurchasEdge points for free HP products.

PurchasEdge member benefits

- A free and easy solution for your empty HP cartridges
- Another way to earn points toward free HP products
- An opportunity to do your part in preserving the planet

How to report returns (excluding pallet returns)

- Log on to www.purchasedge.com/go/recycling.
- Select the type of cartridges returned.
- Submit the number of cartridges returned.
- Provide a UPS tracking number for each shipment.*

Point award rates

Individual inkjet = 2 points per cartridge

Bulk inkjet = 5 points per cartridge

Individual LaserJet = 5 points per cartridge

Bulk LaserJet = 10 points per cartridge

A bulk inkjet return is defined as 10 or more cartridges returned at one time. A bulk LaserJet return is defined as 2 or more cartridges taped together, in a collection box or returned via a pallet. Earn more points and use fewer shipping materials by returning in bulk.

Earned points

Points are monitored by an automated system. Once returns are verified, points are uploaded to your account and available for redemption within 5–14 working days. Points for pallet returns will be uploaded to your account after pick up; members do not need to submit pallet return information online.

Tape up to 8 cartridge boxes together and return via one prepaid shipping label, use your own suitable box, or request a free bulk collection box (holds 20 cartridges) from www.hp.com/recycle and ship via one prepaid shipping label.

PALLET RETURN FACT SHEET

HP Planet Partners pallet return and recycling program

HP Planet Partners now accepts pallet returns for recycling large quantities of HP print cartridges (75+ LaserJet cartridges or 2000+ inkjet cartridges) by the pallet. Members can save time and the environment by returning empty print cartridges by the pallet.

Here's how:

- Members collect empty Original HP LaserJet and inkjet print cartridges in large quantities. Only HP cartridges will be accepted. Please do not send non-HP cartridges, warranty returns or refilled or remanufactured cartridges.
- Member palletizes cartridges
 - HP LaserJet and inkjet cartridge returns are required to be on separate pallets.
 - HP LaserJet print cartridges: Please remove all packaging, place in a Gaylord box or multiple bulk boxes, shrink wrap and palletize.
 - HP inkjet print cartridges: Please remove all packaging, place in a plastic-lined Gaylord box or multiple plastic-lined bulk boxes, shrink wrap and palletize.
 - Any suitable box may be used for shipping. HP bulk boxes may also be ordered free of charge at www.hp.com/recycle. These boxes hold approximately 20 HP LaserJet or 200 inkjet cartridges.
- Member requests pallet pick-up at www.hp.com/recycle.
- Member receives confirmation of pallet pick-up with date and FedEx bill of lading to print, sign and provide to FedEx at time of pick-up.
- Pallets are picked up by FedEx National LTL.
